DADDY JENK'S MEMORIAL PARK REPORT
Semi-Annual Conference, Queen Anne's County Fairgrounds
April 8, 2017

November 1st 2016, I met with Les Brown, J & L Stonework at the Daddy Jenks Memorial located at National 4-H Conference Center. We discussed what we should do with the benches that were sunken into the ground, rocks loose or missing on the memorial and the sink hole behind the memorial. We felt the benches should be on a concrete pad, sinkhole filled in with stone and stone replaced on memorial. As I lifted off a bench on the standards we saw that some of them were not even placed on the standards correctly.

He agreed to raise, set and clean all benches on a 48x16 concrete pad, fill in sink hole behind memorial and replace stone on memorial estimated approximately \$850, possibly a little more.

On Jan 21, 2017 they began work setting concrete pads. Then on January 24, 2017, I drove up to the National 4-H Center to observe as they set the benches, also gluing the seat to the standards as well for safety if someone moved the seat. They cleaned the benches up, filled the sinkhole with stones and also added more stone to the memorial and bench area. I think they did an excellent job for a final cost of \$1075.00. The Park will look great in the spring when the leaves are blown off into the woods.

I also met with Paul Koehler, Sr. Vice President and General Manager, National 4-H Center and he was very pleased with the work being accomplished and our care of the park. He stated there were many personnel that worked at the center that utilized the park during good weather just to get away from work to relax and meditate.

Copies of the invoice have been given to Debbie Ross, Medicine Man and to Maryland 4-H Foundation for payment.
